Collaboration between the Episcopal Diocese of Ohio and the Anglican Diocese of Belize

Science Lead Teachers:

- *Belize teachers are being trained researched hands-on science teaching methods and strategies, by Ohio teachers, to be used within their classrooms.
- *They are also being trained to be educational leaders within their schools.

Professional Pen Pals:

- *Teachers and retired teachers from the Diocese of Ohio are paired with Science Lead Teachers in Belize
- *The Pen Pals support the Lead Teachers as they implement science research-based teaching strategies.

Science Summer Camp Belize, 2017 and 2108

- *80 elementary students took part in a 4 day camp like environment.
- *They took part in 16 activities based on Earth, Physical, Life and Space sciences.
- *Four Ohio teachers paired up with four Lead Teachers to teach the camp lessons.
- *The Lead Teachers then trained their fellow teachers, in the fall, on how to run a science camp and how to use the 16 camp activities within their own classrooms.
- *100% of donations will sponsor student camp scholarships.

- *The Small Grants are intended to support Belize Science Lead Teachers, in their efforts to develop, Improve and expand innovative instructional programs, projects, and activities in science related areas
