## **Sample Code of Conduct**

Most groups find it important to agree to a code of conduct prior to departure. This will be particularly useful with youth groups. This sample was drawn from a code of conduct used by a group of parishes that worked together to travel to Belize. You may want to customize a code to your particular circumstances, but this sample will give you a good place to start.

## **Sample Code Of Conduct**

- 1. No drinking
- 2. No sex
- 3. Nothing illegal: in the US or host country
- 4. Show respect to everyone; treat others as you would want to be treated
- 5. Use good manners, be polite (and culturally sensitive)
- 6. Share all resources with others
- 7. Look out for each other
- 8. Respect everyone's (including own) space
- 9. Always have a buddy
- 10. Only go into other hotel rooms if invited and if appropriate
- 11. Everyone treated as adult
- 12. Be on time
- 13. Don't form exclusive groups, including toward hosts
- 14. Be open to differences, including beliefs and ways of life
- 15. Be respectful to the land
- 16. No whining, think before you speak
- 17. Stay positive
- 18. Always communicate feelings out loud so no one is confused
- 19. Identify leaders
- 20. Listen to everyone's opinions and ideas
