

Global Mission Opportunities 2019

Shorter-term Mission Opportunities:

- **Cristosal** (www.cristosal.org) works in El Salvador and offers a variety of courses through its Global School, as well as pilgrimages and custom trips. Its programs focus on human rights, community development and local empowerment. (Cost: approx. \$1000-\$1200/pp)
- **The Dominican Development Group** (dominicandevdevelopmentgroup.org) is working in the Dominican Republic. DDG can help with customized facilitation, planning and deployment for mission teams of all sizes throughout the year, including construction, pilgrimage and medical mission.
- **El Hogar** (www.elhogar.org) operates four schools for abandoned and poor students, and welcomes service teams of up to 15 members most weeks of the year. (\$2500/team + \$250/pp)
- **Grey Dove** (www.greydove.us). Grey Dove coordinates medical mission teams to Haiti for both medical and non-medical personnel, as well as conducting conferences on best medical mission practices. Their next trip is scheduled for January 7-10, 2019 to Bondeau, Haiti.
- **Jerusalem Peacebuilders** (www.jerusalempeacebuilders.org) offers travel & pilgrimage opportunities to the Holy Land for a variety of adult groups and faith communities. A Jerusalem and Holy Land Pilgrimage is scheduled for April 30-May 12, 2019 (\$3375 pp/do).
- **Maison de Naissance** (www.globalbirthinghomefoundation.org) is a modern, culturally appropriate maternal center, established in 2004 in Torbeck, Haiti, and is sponsored by Global Birthing Home Foundation. The organization leads one or two immersion and project trips each year. An Immersion Trip is planned for Feb 17-23, 2019 (\$1600 pp/do).

Longer-term Mission Opportunities:

- **Young Adult Service Corps (or YASC)** is currently accepting applications for young adults 21-30 who are interesting in serving for a one-year placement. The application deadline is January 11, 2019. Visit www.episcopalchurch.org/yasc for more information.
- **Episcopal Volunteers in Mission** (www.episcopalchurch.org/mission-personnel) is for adults 30+ who are interested in exploring long-term mission. Applications are due on a rolling basis with a two-week cross-cultural orientation program, which takes place in late June of each year. Contact the Mission Personnel office for more information and for assistance with discernment.
